Board meeting April 29, 2020 using Zoom. Results

OSSSL will pay field fee for games played March 1 and March 8, 2020

Spring 2020 half of season cancelled due to COVID-19

Replaced with Fall 2020 games. All games played between September 2019 and

December 2020 will count in standings for alignment for 2021 Season. Any

suspensions will sitout games once we restart games.

\$300 fee paid by team will be applied to Fall 2020 games.

Season moved to Calendar year. Spring 2021 session plus Fall 2021 session

Player passes and game cards to be distributed in Feb 2021 for 2021 Season

One game added to future sessions (changed from 11 to 12 games, that is 24 games per Season(year))

Turn in Player passes, game cards, rosters (9 players, includes 3 women minimum) and annual player registration fees (\$15 each) for following season by end of December (instead of end of June)

Alignment Committee meeting will be in January (instead of July)

Field fee due from teams in February. Amount to be determined later by Board.

September 13, 2020 (first game of session) all games will be at Fremont Central Park (if parks are open)

Livermore June Cup (June 27-28) Cancelled

Fremont Adult Soccer (August 1-2) Waiting on city to open fields. Decision mid-June.

First games of 2021 Season Sunday, Feb 28. Fall session first game Aug 29, 2021. (All games will be in Fremont Central Park but date may change due to possible conflict with youth tournaments)

HOME TEAM

Make sure you have a field and time for home games.

Notify opponent visiting team two weeks before scheduled game.

Provide filled out game card to referee.

Responsible for field setup (15 min grace time)

TEAM and REFEREE REMINDERS

Teams must field at least 7 players (1 woman minimum) to play.

Maximum 5 men field players. (woman in goal does not mean 6 men field players are allowed)

15 minute grace time. (referee may shorten halves if started late)

Provide player pass for every player. Referee may require second photo ID.

Guests must fill out and sign game card waiver before entering field. Must also be signed by opponent team representative. Need not wait until half time if guest is late.

In >30 divisions: Maximum two women between 25 and 27 may play in a game. Only first two playing are allowed. (e.g. One guest and one roster player start the game, second roster player arrives late, MAY NOT PLAY even if guest leaves)

If a team must cancel a game, they must notify opponents and referees (or referee scheduler) more than 24 hours before scheduled game time. Also notify Rich Cortez, richlanicortez@gmail.com

A team cancelling with less than 24-hour notice must pay entire referee fee (\$90) and forfeiting team is a visiting team they must pay half the field fee.

Severe penalty for illegal players (e.g. playing without a pass, guest playing before filling out game card, playing before referee has checked credentials, using another player's pass, playing while under red card suspension)

Team is fined \$100 if a guest is sent off by the referee.

Referee fee:

\$45 from each team, 2 referees (age 18+)

\$45 from each team, Referee (age 21+) with two ARs (age 16+)

\$30 from each team for solo referee (age 21+)

Referees should check every player pass to confirm player identity

Referee may ask for another photo ID to confirm identification. No second photo ID, no play.

Two Guest players can be 2 men, 2 women, 1 man & 1 woman

Guest players **must** fill out and sign the game card waiver and opponent team **must** sign, verifying age, before player is allowed on the field

Okay to leave gamecard with a team if guest is to arrive late. **Must** still get guest and opponent signatures. Guests do NOT have to wait until half time if not ready by kickoff

Do not start clock before notifying teams and giving time to enter field.

Only shorten halves if game starts more than ten minutes after scheduled start time.

Forfeit if a team does not have 7 players by 15 minutes after scheduled time. Note on game card.

Teams are allowed to check player passes and game card to confirm no more than 2 women age between 25 and 27.

Have teams checked in, coin toss, and enter field before scheduled kickoff time.

If game starts more than 10 minutes after scheduled start time, reduce both halves by 5 minutes, NOT 35 min first half and 45 min second half.

Sitout for Referee Dissent caution is 15 minutes (other cautions 10 minutes)

Substitutions may be requested at ANY stoppage

Women must take penalty kicks.

Referees: Enter scores, caution, and send-off information into GameOfficials.

2019 Law Changes

Drop ball to Goalie Play if play is stopped with ball in Penalty Area,

Drop to team who last touched Play if play is stopped with ball outside PA, (All other players 4.5 yds away)

Wall of 3+ players, all opponents at least one yard away

Goal-Kick, Ball is in play when kicked and moves

Opponents stay outside PA until ball is in play

Hand ball:

Touch hand/arm and goes into goal

Touch hand/arm, gains control, scores or goal-scoring opportunity

Touch extend hand/arm

NOT hand ball

Touches hand/arm from head/body/foot

Touches hand/arm close to body

Touches hand/arm reaching to ground when falling

Goalie blows attempt to clear a throw-in or kick from team-mate may handle

Kickoff: coin toss winner chooses end or kickoff

Player substituted must leave field at nearest point

2020 Law Changes

Arm starts at the bottom of the armpit (for determining handball)

DEFINITIONS

MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING: Any member not serving a Disciplinary penalty.

MEMBER: Any person properly registered on an OSSSL team.

TEAM MEMBER: A person where credentials have been verified and a player pass created.

SEASON: All games included in a calendar year. Realignment is done once per year/season.

SESSION: A group of scheduled games. Thirty-and-older division has two eleven-game sessions per season/year. Masters Division has multiple sessions per season/year.

PROPER NOTIFICATION: Notification for which a response is received. Merely leaving a telephone message or sending an email is not sufficient

TACKLE: Any challenge for the ball. (FIFA)

SLIDE TACKLE: A feet-first sliding challenge for the ball where any part of the body other than feet make contact with the ground.

PLAYING DISTANCE: Distance to the ball which allows a player to touch the ball by extending the foot/leg or for an overhead ball jumping up, or for goalkeepers, jumping up with arms extended.
(FIFA)

FAIR CHARGE: Shoulder to shoulder while attempting to play the ball.
